# Californian Proposition 65 (Prop 65) Company Policy Statement 

The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, 1986 (Proposition 65) was introduced in California in 1986. Its objectives are to promote clean drinking water and inform the public of possible exposure to substances known by the state of California to cause cancer and/or birth defects.
RLS is a manufacturer of industrial products intended to be installed by trained engineers and used by skilled operatives in an industrial manufacturing environment.

RLS has carried out a review of the products being supplied into California and of the materials used in their construction. As a result of this RLS believes that users installing, maintaining, and operating RLS products as designed and instructed will not be exposed to harmful levels of any substances on the current OEHHA list.

To ensure continued compliance, RLS will monitor changes to the OEHHA list, to Proposition 65 requirements and to the materials used in the manufacture of its products and will provide a warning label in accordance with Proposition 65 requirements where this is found to be necessary.
RLS is committed to managing the use of chemical substances in accordance with governmental regulations, industry standards, and customer-specific requirements to ensure that all aspects of our business have the least harmful effect on the environment. Consistent with industry practices, RLS does not support analytical testing for toxic substances. Information is based on the knowledge of materials used in the finished products and information provided by suppliers.
