

Californian Proposition 65 (Prop 65) – Company Policy Statement

The Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act, 1986 (Proposition 65) was introduced in California in 1986. Its objectives are to promote clean drinking water and inform the public of possible exposure to substances known by the state of California to cause cancer and/or birth defects.

RLS has carried out a review of the products being supplied to California and of the materials used in their construction. None of the listed substances are directly used in RLS production procedures. However, these substances may be present as naturally occurring components of raw materials or as residuals from the manufacturing process. Consistent with industry practices, RLS does not support analytical testing for toxic substances. Information is based on the knowledge of materials used in the finished products and information provided by suppliers.

As a result of this RLS believes that trained professional users, who follow appropriate safety protocols, including the use of personal protective equipment (PPE) and adherence to safety data sheets (SDS), installing, maintaining, and operating RLS products as designed and instructed will not be exposed to harmful levels of any substances on the current OEHHA list. As such, no Proposition 65 warning is currently deemed necessary for these products under expected conditions of use.

To ensure continued compliance, RLS is monitoring changes to the OEHHA list, to Proposition 65 requirements and to the materials used in the manufacture of its products and will provide a warning label in accordance with Proposition 65 requirements where this is found to be necessary.
