

The PWP Directive - Company Policy Statement

European Parliament and Council Directive 94/62/EC on packaging and packaging waste (PWP)

RLS is committed to managing the use of chemical substances in accordance with governmental regulations, industry standards, and customer-specific requirements to ensure that all aspects of our business have the least harmful effect on the environment. RLS requires from suppliers that all delivered goods are compliant to applicable EU legislation. In accordance with ECHA guidance and consistent with industry practices, RLS does not support analytical testing for SVHCs and other chemicals. Information is based on the knowledge of materials used in the finished products, including products packages, and information provided by suppliers.

EU Directive 94/62/EC (and US CONEG legislation) apply to Packaging and Packaging Waste and not directly to their constituents. To help you evaluating the conformity of your own product, the manufacturer provides the following information:

According to information provided by packaging suppliers RLS believes that the sum of concentration levels of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium present in packaging or packaging components is not expected to exceed 100 ppm by weight in packaging's of RLS products, as requested by both legislations.

This information is not part of the sales specifications and RLS does not exclude the possible presence of traces of heavy metals impurities.

The information is provided as of the date hereof. Monitoring continues as new products are added to our portfolio.
